



### Santa Cruz - 1990

A Sport Utility Vehicle ahead of its time - this vehicle was designed for extreme bicycling enthusiasts. This concept styling exercise was a student design project (Art Center College of Design) based on the mechanical platform of the popular Toyota "Previa" mini-van. Santa Cruz features a vertical pick-up bed which provides for very ergonomic access to the bicycle storage space, capable of holding 4 bicycles and 4 spare bike tires. 1/5 scale made of automotive styling clay over a wood buck. •



### Ghiaccio - 1991

Ghiaccio, the Italian translation for "ice" is an extreme automotive design study which derives its color, lines, and forms from glacial ice. The vehicle is a true mid-engined super sports car, designed to compete in the market place (and on the track!) with the likes of Acura's NSX, Lamborghinis, and any mid-engined thoroughbred from Marnello's (Ferrari) stable of mounts. 1/5 scale made of automotive styling clay over a wood buck. •
